



# **B OLD GRAIN ELEVATOR**

The Pontypool Grain Elevator, built in 1918, is one of two freestanding grain elevators in Ontario. It is in the village of Pontypool, beside the CP Rail track. Donated by CP Rail to the Manvers Twp. Historical Society, it will become a tourist information centre and museum and recognize the Jewish citizens who summered in Pontypool 1920-1960. Beside an old shed are the foundations of the old train station with the original tracks still in place.

Manvers Township Historical Society representatives will be on site to answer any questions.





## **F MANVERS RESEARCH CENTRE** (OLD BETHANY POST OFFICE)

This is the oldest, restored, free standing post office in Ontario. Built in 1878, it was first used as a grain office for the Midland Railroad. From 1902 to 1919, J.J. Preston, Conservative MPP, Durham East, had his constituency office here. In 1911 it was moved to make way for a new rail line. From 1938 to 1983, it was a Canada Post Office. In 1985 it was moved back from Highway 7A and purchased by Manvers Twp Historical Society, and is now the Manyers Research Centre, Manyers Township Historical Society representatives will be on site to answer any questions.
